This year we want to limit DCYHA's participation to fundraising events in which our membership enjoys participating. Please show your interest by signing up to lead, help with, or attend the activities listed below.

Chuck-a-puck

- This is where we sell discounted Grizzlies tickets to our membership, sell orange foam pucks on game night, collect pucks thrown on the ice, and split the puck selling proceeds with the Grizzlies
- Co-ordinate with Grizzlies: get possible dates, pickup tickets, split money
- Co-ordinate with team managers: pick dates, deliver tickets in exchange for money collected by managers, bring new managers up to speed
- Last year we participated in 2 Chuck-a-pucks nights and netted roughly \$500

Board Favorites

- This is a list of local businesses, primarily restaurants and hotels that the DCYHA Board of Directors recommends to visiting families
- Write, call, and/or visit local businesses who made \$50 donations last year and solicit new donors using previously set up contacts in salesforce.com, update last year's Board Favorite flyer and distribute
- Last year this program was setup by one person and netted approximately \$600

Spook-Tacular

- This is where we help the South Davis Recreation Center (SDRC) staff its Halloween Party and get roughly \$20/6 hour shift worked between 4:00 to 10:00PM
- Solicit and schedule volunteers, coordinate with SDRC
- Last year about 25 kids and parents participated and we raised about \$500

Concession Tables

- This is where we set up a concession/apparel table near the ice sheet at home games
- Restock items, brew coffee, heat water, setup and teardown, find volunteers to help staff tables, make change
- This isn't a big money maker but it helps build our community relations
